EXPECTATIONS OF OUR MEMBERS

Australian Sports Sedans Association Inc. (ASSA Inc.) was established for the association of persons interested in the encouragement and development of all forms of Motorsport including competition driving, precision driving, trials, rallies and automotive engineering and design. As well, to promote the development of Motorsport in all of its forms (refer Rules 2.1 and 2.3 of ASSA Inc.)

To fulfill these purposes, ASSA Inc. expects of its members that they act within the rules and spirit of our sport, they encourage and support opportunities for participation in all aspects of our sport and they prioritise the safety and well-being of children and young people involved in our sport. As a guide -

- Be aware of and act within the rules and spirit of Australian Sports Sedans motorsport.
- Promote fair play over winning at any cost.
- Encourage and support opportunities for people to learn appropriate behavior and skills.
- Support opportunities for participation in all aspects of the sport.
- Treat each person as an individual and show respect and courtesy to all involved with the sport.
- Respect the rights and worth of every person, regardless of their age, race, gender, ability, cultural background, sexuality or religion.
- Respect the decisions of all officials and administrators.
- Display appropriate and responsible behavior in all interactions.
- Display responsible behavior in relation to alcohol and other drugs.
- Act with integrity and objectivity, and accept responsibility for your decisions and actions.
- Ensure your decisions and actions contribute to a safe, harassment-free environment.
- Do not tolerate abusive, bullying or threatening behavior.

Persons eligible for membership are anyone who supports these purposes (refer Rule 7 of ASSA Inc.).

Should a person not support these purposes ASSA Inc. may reject any application for membership and no reason need be given for the rejection (refer Rule 10(4) of ASSA Inc.). If accepted as a member, ASSA Inc may thereafter take disciplinary action against a member if the member has either failed to comply with the Rules, refused to support the purposes of ASSA Inc. or has engaged in conduct prejudicial to ASSA Inc. (refer Rule 19 of ASSA Inc.). Under certain circumstances cyber bullying (e.g., bullying that is carried out through an internet service such as email, a chat room, discussion group, instant messaging or website) is a criminal offence that can be reported to the police. Likewise, members who publish false or misleading comments about another person in the public domain (e.g., Facebook, YouTube or X) may be liable for defamation.

What we ask you to do: We expect our members to observe the purposes stated above. ASSA Inc. encourages a positive interaction and positive experience between its members and those external to the Club with who we interact.

What we will do: ASSA Inc. will provide an environment which upholds the Clubs purposes and otherwise take the necessary steps to provide such an environment for both its members and those external to the club with who we interact.
